

- 2. <u>Discussion</u> Why do these groups of people dislike each other or even hate each other?
 - * <u>Prejudice</u> means judging before you know the facts, or holding an opinion without any real evidence. Prejudice is based on feeling rather than fact.

* Causes of Prejudice

- * We are afraid of what is different, or what we don't understand.
- * We like to be with people who are like us, to protect ourselves.
- Some people who are educated feel proud and look down on others.
- * Some groups have wealth and position and don't want to share it with other groups.
