REMEMBER

The single letter **d** can be at the start, middle or end of a word. The **dd** is usually in the middle straight after letters **a, e, i, o, u** if they say  **a**  **e**  **i**  **o** **a** or  **u** **o**. **D** starts sentences and the names of people and places.

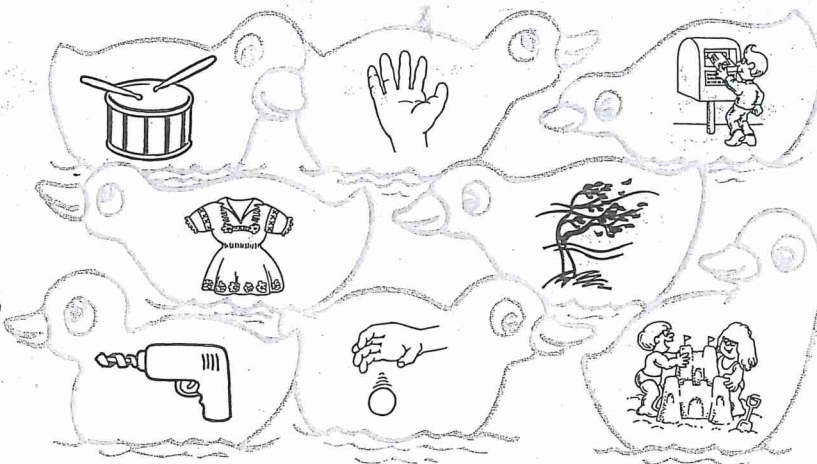
